Student Objectives:

Educator Preparation:

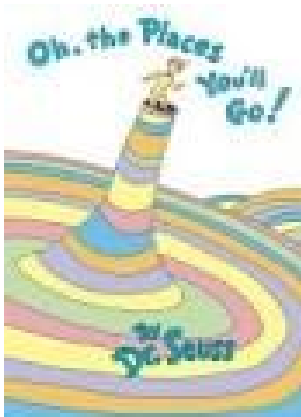
- The book *Oh the Places You'll Go!* by Dr. Seuss.
- Writing Paper.

Introduction:

Sometimes we feel like we are not worthy of the future we dream of. We are the only person who gets to decide what our future looks like.

Instruction:

Read the book *Oh the Places You'll Go!* by Dr. Seuss.



Interaction:

- Not feeling smart enough or talented enough can really make you feel bad about yourself.
- Guide students into positive thinking and future goal-setting.

Closure:

- Students recognize the future is theirs.
- Students begin goal setting.

Activity:

Students write about what they want to be when they grow up and how they will get there.
